


CLUB

Youth learn to participate in shooting sports safely. Training conducted by Certified Shooting Sports Instructors with state and national credentials.

In order to compete in 4-H Shooting Sports, youth must attend 50% of the scheduled practices in order to compete at State 4-H Competition that is held in September 2023. Also the 4-H eligibility roster for state deadline is June 25, 2023, which means they must start practicing prior to June 25. Please note: Refer with your specific county for enrollment details.

Any youth interested in receiving financial assistance to attend a 4-H activity (such as camp) may apply for scholarships.


The Community Service scholarship is based on the youth completing community service work. For every 10 hours of service, the youth can receive a \$40.00 scholarship.

The guidelines are as follows:

- 1. Youth cannot receive more than TWO scholarships.
- 2. The calendar year for the program is July 1- June 30.
- 3. All community service work must be done for a non-profit agency or completed with a group community service project.
- 4. All community service hours must be completed and submitted to the Extension Office 10 days prior to the 4-H activity/event.


