

The Community Service scholarship is based on the youth completing community service work. For every 10 hours of service, the youth can receive a \$50.00 scholarship.

The guidelines are as follows:

- 1. Youth cannot receive more than THREE scholarships.
- 2. The calendar year for the program is July 1-June 30.
- All community service work must be done for a non-profit agency or completed with a group community service project.
- 4. All community service hours must be completed and submitted to the Extension Office 10 days before the 4-H activity/event.
